What is Simplicity of Speech?

Fewness & Fullness of Words

Jesus & fewness of words

As soon as it was morning, the chief priests had a meeting with the elders, scribes, and the whole Sanhedrin. After tying Jesus up, they led Him away and handed Him over to Pilate. WORDS REVEALOUR INNER WORLDS

Simplicity of speech flows from a heart that has bonded with the heart of Jesus: compassionate and truthful, loving and good.



A good man produces good out of the good storeroom of his heart. An evil man produces evil out of the evil storeroom, for his mouth speaks from the overflow of the heart.

How do we cultivate simplicity of speech?

My speech and my proclamation were not with persuasive words of wisdom but with a powerful demonstration by the Spirit, so that your faith might not be based on men's wisdom but on God's power. We also speak these things, not in words taught by human wisdom, but in those taught by the Spirit, explaining spiritual things to spiritual people.
